

CAPTAIN WILFRED 'BILLIE' NEVILL

Commissioned to commemorate the 177 boys from Dover College who died during WWI.

Former pupil Wilfred Nevill became famous as the officer who kicked a football into No Man's Land at the start of the Battle of the Somme.

Sadly Billie was shot and killed in front of the German barbed wire.



LILY PARR

Football Association sponsor Mars commissioned this life size sculpture of trailblazing footballer Lily Parr.

The sculpture is on permanent display at the National Football Museum in Manchester and is the first sculpture of a female football player in the country.



MARY AND JESUS, MOTHER AND SON

Originally commissioned by The London Oratory School, this sculpture shows Jesus age 16 with his Mother, Mary.

Two additional casts of this sculpture were made for schools in Australia. One travelled by plane and one travelled by boat.



HAULING MAN

This Bronze figure of a rope worker pulling on three ropes was commissioned by Kier for the new Tesco store at Hailsham.



The sculpture celebrates the history of rope making in the area.








CLAY SCULPTURE OF A LITTLE GIRL






